Total number of Islamic MSS: 49 (27 Arabic; 10 Persian; 12 Turkic).

Description of collection: The oldest Arabic MS. is *Fatāwā Qāḍī-Khān*, dated 970 H. / 1562–63 CE; other texts include Qurʾān, Qurʾanic studies, *fiqh*, *ḥadīth*, history, poetry, literary prose and Sufism.

Systematic description of the 27 Arabic MSS, with indexes of titles, authors and copyists.
